



NRAA Rules, Safety and Technical Sub Committee

The NRAA is seeking appropriately experienced and enthusiastic persons from the S&Ts to apply for a position on the NRAA Rules, Safety and Technical Sub Committee, reporting to the nominated NRAA Director.

Duration: One year plus option to extend for a further one year.

- 1. Meeting as required (virtually by video conference) to address priority issues otherwise progress meetings to be held every quarter commencing in late April 2023.
- 2. The Sub-Committee will have focus areas requiring people of differing skill sets:
 - The NRAA Chief Range Officer
 - A discipline representative from each of: Target Rifle, F-Class, Service Rifle, PSR, Sporter/Hunter.
 - Sub Committee Members: Up to 6 individuals, but ability to call in other specific expertise as required (eg NRAA armourer, person with range design/assessment credentials and experience).
- 3. All members of the sub-committee sign a non-disclosure agreement.
- 4. There may be day-to-day tasking with the Executive Officer.

Terms of reference:

- 1. Initial focus is on a review and update of Standard Shooting Rules for a July 2023 publication target.
- 2. Review of ICFRA Rules for adoption within SSRs.
- 3. Review of progress on RO safety training and development of the next phase focused on increased understanding of SSRs.
- 4. Investigation, testing and advice on ammunition and components input from Project Group focused on these items.

Key Outcome being sought by the Sub-Committee

To ensure the Standard Shooting Rules (SSR's) are kept up to date and relevant to our sport and that communication of all changes are distributed in consultation with the States and Territories.
