Appointment to IT Systems Development Committee

The NRAA is seeking appropriately experienced persons with IT skills and expertise to form an IT Systems Committee.

The Committee will report to NRAA Board member – James Varty.

1) Duration:

The Committee is expected to run for between 12mths to 18mths and be responsible for the development of new IT systems for NRAA.

2) Requirements of Membership:

- a) Meeting as required (including by video conference) to determine and progress project issues.
- b) Capacity to undertake and complete tasks as allocated.
- c) Committee numbers are expected to be up to 6 (in addition to the Chair and NRAA Office representation) and be drawn from across the sport, including from S&T organisations as appropriate.

3) Terms of Reference:

The Committee will be tasked with defining, scoping, appointing a contractor and overseeing the implementation of new systems for NRAA. The system is to cover:

- a) a new NRAA website and back-end
- b) a new Events system for use by both NRAA and its member State and Territory (S&T) organisations
- c) an on-line membership system for Clubs, S&T organisations and NRAA
- d) an updated OPMP system for member competition rankings

Consultation with S&T organisations will be a requirement.

4) Criteria:

The following skills are considered desirable:

- a) involvement in systems development and administration of sports organisations
- b) experience in scoping and implementing IT systems
- c) experience in management of competitions and their IT support required in fullbore or other sports.
- d) An understanding of the OPMP ranking system and how it can be upgraded to include all disciplines
- e) experience in being part of a Committee which works cohesively together to achieve a best outcome.

Key Outcome of the Committee

To deliver to NRAA and its S&T members an IT system which provides the 4 key items specified in (3), automating current manual processes, at a sensible cost. The developer of the system must provide on-going maintenance support and be on-going developing its system, including across other sports.
