- 5) Kaltenberg Cup / Mace Medal scores to be added to the scores to count for the Grand Aggregate
- 6) Kaltenberg Cup/Mace Medal - :
 - TR: Top 10* of The President's and The King's Prize carry over. *Or a number as agreed by the NRAA at their discretion.
 - F Class: Top 10* from F Open, Top 4* from FTR, Top 4* from FSTD of The President's and The King's Prize carry over. *Or a number as agreed by the NRAA at their discretion.
