The *Captain's Meeting* will be held on Sunday 17th November at 4:30pm or as soon as possible after the ACT Championships presentation is completed. Venue is inside the Canberra Rifle Club main building near the office.

PRESENTATION DINNER

Presentation Dinner - will be held on Wednesday evening 20th November, commencing at 7:00pm (photos from 6pm) at Thoroughbred Park https://thoroughbredpark.com.au/about-us, located just 12 minutes from the rifle range and 15 minutes from the heart of the City, off Northbourne Avenue. There is plenty of free parking on site and a dedicated function room with views.

Persons who are members of a State or Territory Team and competing at NRAA sanctioned events acknowledge and consent to the taking of photographs and electronic images at this competition. Photographs and images may be used by the NRAA for promotional, marketing or other purposes and to promote the sport of target rifle shooting in general. These photographs and images may continue to be used by NRAA beyond the period of an individual's Team membership and their membership of NRAA, its member State & Territory Associations and their affiliated clubs.

LUNCH CATERING

Lunch catering will be provided during the ACT Championships and the Teams matches. For the Teams matches, this will ONLY be available on pre-order and payment direct to the caterers by 3pm the day before. This is up to Teams to organise for themselves. Team lunch order forms will be included in Captain's packs distributed at the Captain's Meeting.

ACT CHAMPIONSHIPS AND ACCOMMODATION

Individual entries for the ACT Championships are required by 31 October. We understand that teams will make their own accommodation arrangements. 
TARGETS

Kongsberg electronic targets will be used for all Teams practices and matches and during the ACT Championships. Each mound has two concrete pads for each target, allowing one shooter to get ready while the other is shooting. There is only one monitor per target, and it must be positioned so that the Coach, Captain and scorers (from another team) plus plotters can all view the screen. See photos on the pages 3-4 for options used by past teams.

Scorers to only be replaced on conclusion of a shooter's stage with verification of scores on monitor and score card completed by the previous scorer. Scorers must be vigilant for sighting shots used by the next shooter and for any crossfires from other targets. Check scoring is not required, but the total stage score (eg 60-7) of each shooter is to be recorded on the team board behind each target for spectator purposes.

For ranges up to and including 800m, target B1 is used as the manual 'zero target' if misses are recorded by commencing shooters on other electronic targets. At 900m target AX will be used as the manual 'zero target' if required.

Note: Cross-firing on targets 8, 9 and X may be required to avoid flag line interference.

The McIntosh Rifle Range has 20 target lanes at 700m and 800m, of which two target lanes may be allocated to manual targets in the event of misses being recorded for sighters. There are 18 team entries (7xFO, 6xFTR, 5xFSTD) so at 700m and 800m there will be a draw to allocate disciplines to the left, centre or right of the range. A further draw shall take place to allocate teams to targets within that discipline grouping. 900m is limited to 9 targets, so different details will be held to cater for the number of teams. In the interests of reducing time on range, there will be a mixed discipline practice, however all FSTD teams will be allocated to the 2nd detail practice so that they can logically flow onto the match afterwards. A draw shall be conducted at 07:45 to determine which discipline (FO and FTR) shall be allocated to the 1st and 2nd 900m details and targets. Should 800m conclude earlier, the next 900m range will follow on immediately. For those who did not have equipment checked during the ACT championships, this will occur during the practice.

Important note to all competitors regarding special conditions for access to the 900m mound from the adjacent SSAA access road:

Parking behind 900m is limited to range officer vehicles and a limited number of vehicles with an official government disability sticker (if the organising committee determine that space permits). There is an adjacent public road to the SSAA range and a drop off area for equipment will be marked out — please drop your gear quickly and park further along the road. Please note however that all rifles MUST be contained within a suitable rifle case or soft bag for transporting to and from your vehicle to the drop off area and the 900m mound. No exposure of firearms or cleaning of rifles is permitted along this road.

At 700m there will be a draw to allocate disciplines to the left, centre or right of the range. A further draw shall take place to allocate teams to targets within that discipline grouping. 900m is limited to 9 targets, so different details will be held to cater for the number of teams. A draw shall also be conducted to determine which discipline (FO and FTR) shall be allocated to the 1st and 2nd 900m details and targets. Should 800m conclude earlier, the next 900m range will follow on immediately. All FSTD teams will not shoot at 900m today as they will have shot the match at 900m the previous day. This allows time for all teams to prepare for the presentation function.
